The body of your abstract begins here. This is the OpenOffice template file for the abstracts (invited and poster) to be submitted to the III BWMD. Use this file to prepare your abstract with OpenOffice. Since the abstracts will be directly reproduced in a volume to be distributed to the attendees, please carefully follow this format and the guidelines provided. To prepare your abstract, replace title, authors (presenting author must be underlined), affiliations and abstract body. Abstract body and references should be single space, fully justified and typed using Times font with normal style and size 12. Neither indentations nor blank lines should appear between paragraphs in the abstract body. OpenOffice symbols and equations are allowed. One figure or one table can be directly inserted in the abstract file (see Figure 1). The figure (image and graphic as jpg or png) should be with 300 dpi resolution. A caption should be added below the figure or table. Up to three references are allowed for each abstract [1, 2, 3]. The abstract is limited to one page. Submit the abstracts electronically, sending an e-mail message to iiibwmdyn@ufsm.br with "Abstract - Presenting author name" in the subject field. Send us your abstract prepared with the provided template you used, with the same original format, once the pdf file of your abstract will be prepared by the Workshop staff. Your abstract submission will be acknowledged within the next 24 h after you sent the message to us. The update of a submitted abstract is possible by sending an e-mail message with the new abstract version to iiibwmdyn@ufsm.br with "Abstract Resubmission - Presenting author name" in the subject field. In the e-mail body, indicate the Abstract Submission Code that you received by e-mail at the first submission. The abstract submission will be available until October 20, 2014, and the file version sent until this date will be considered as definitive. Corresponding authors will be notified of acceptance/rejection of their abstract via e-mail. Thank you for contributing to the III BWMD, and see you in Santa Maria on November 19-21, 2014.
